 - Tonja Fillippino- School Experience Report- all above 80%, Employers Questionnaire for teachers with 3yrs or less experience- scored above 80% for all but classroom management
 - Rusty Young- Ed TPA- 2.2 pts below national average
 - Natalie Johnson-Leslie- Diversity survey- ensure all programs looking at diversity, recommends new instrument to measure
 - Amanda Lambertus- PLT scores- did well, writing was lowest
 - Alicia Shaw- Praxis scores for Building Level- 97% pass rate, equity, Inclusiveness, and Cultural Response lowest
 - Jackie McBride- Site Mentor Evaluations for District Level- all above 80%, increase response rate
 - Julie Lamb-Milligan- Minority candidates mean ranged 21-27%, well above national average, female to male 71-94% in all but EDS Superintendent
 - Robert Williams- Curriculum Praxis 100% pass rate, Completer Survey had a poor response rate
 - Ryan Kelly- MSE Reading 27/29 passed, EDS Praxis 17/21 passed
