Students must pass BFA Review in ART 3123 Creative Practice before enrolling in upper-level coursework.

ART 3000-level's include: ART3093 Ceramics, ART3063 Painting, ART 3083 Printmaking, ART3113 Fiber Arts, ART3103 Sculpture, ART3403 Photography, ART3523 2D Animation & Graphics

Students must declare area of specialization; 15 hours of study in area of specialization are required (includes 3000-level studio core course in area of specialization). Areas include: Animation, Ceramics, Drawing, Fiber Arts, Painting, Photography, Printmaking, or Sculpture.
