Jeannie,

I have attached the proposed 21-22 PRT criteria for CNHP. We updated the scholarship portion of the tenure requirements to include : “During the six-year pre-tenure period, the individual shall have completed a minimum of two peer reviewed publications as primary or sole author and some combination of four (4) additional activities from those listed as examples by the College as appropriate research and scholarly activities for the **academic** track or from the scholarship and practice activities for the **clinical** track. Given the length of time required to complete a peer reviewed publication, it is recommended that individuals have one publication submitted prior to the third-year review.” Prior to this, it stated a minimum of six activities and did not specify publications.
